	Describe as fully as possible the actual or potential risk to or from the young person, and what the warning signs or triggers are.	Indicate any measures that are believed to reduce the risk, or any responses that have been employed successfully to manage it.	H= Recent and frequent occurrence of behaviour M= Recent but infrequent occurrence of behaviour L= Not within last 3 months, and infrequent occurrence of behaviour
Self Harm- indicate all types of self harming behaviour(s) e.g. cutting, substance misuse, prostitution, attempted suicide, eating disorders			
Risk to residents- indicate all types of risk e.g. physical, sexual, verbal or all			
Risk to staff- indicate all types of risk e.g. physical, sexual, verbal or all			
Risk to or from the community- indicate whether from drugs, offending, abuse, prostitution, reprisal attacks			
Accommodation- indicate risks in relation to security, damage, barricading in, climbing on, outbuildings, roads etc. Indicate risk in relation to fire setting and any patterns of any previous occurrences			
Outings and Activities- indicate risks in relation to absconding, theft, criminal or dangerous substances etc.
